Leave granted to the learned advocate on record of the petitioners to implead the Chairman, DPSC, Howrah as party respondent in the instant writ petition. Let a copy of the writ petition be served upon Mr. Ratul Biswas, learned advocate representing the added respondent.

The petitioners applied for mutual transfer. Their application is pending consideration at the end of the Chairman, DPSC, Howrah.

Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Chairman, DPSC, Howrah to consider the said application in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

The Board shall seek the necessary information as regards the status of the teachers and the vacancy position from the concerned District Primary School Council who shall immediately transfer the required data to the Board for compliance of the direction passed hereinabove.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application for seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
