Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.

Leave granted to the advocate on record of the petitioners to implead the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Bardhaman as party respondent in the instant writ petition. The formality of serving a copy of the writ petition upon the added respondent stands dispensed with as the Council is represented by the learned counsel.

The petitioners applied for mutual transfer. Their application is pending consideration at the end of the District Primary School Council.

Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Bardhaman to consider the said application in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

As the petitioner no.2 has already put in more than two years of service, accordingly, the Council will not insist upon production of the letter of confirmation from the petitioner no. 2 at the time of consideration of the application seeking transfer.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application for seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
