A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

As the petitioner no. 1 has already put in more than two years of service, accordingly, the Council will not insist upon production of the letter of confirmation from the petitioner no.1 at the time of consideration of the application seeking transfer.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
