Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.

Leave granted to the advocate on record of the petitioners to implead the Chairman, District Primary School Council, South 24-Parganas as party respondent in the instant writ petition. Let copy of the writ petition be served upon Mr. Gourav Das, learned advocate who represents the DPSC, South 24-Pgs.

The petitioners applied for mutual transfer. Their application is pending consideration at the end of the Chairman, District Primary School Council, South 24-Parganas.

Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Chairman, District Primary School Council, South 24-Parganas to consider the said application in accordance

with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
