1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Considering the materials available in the case diary and the submissions made on behalf of the de facto complainant that the petitioner and the de facto complaint are presently resident peacefully and happily and, moreover, also having regard to the fact that the injury report shows that the nature of the injury is simple, we are of the view that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner (Kamarujjaman Sk @ Kamarujjamman Shaikh @ Raja Shaikh @ Sk.) shall be released on bail upon

furnishing a bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two registered sureties of like amount, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, corresponding to Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

4. The petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court within two weeks.
5. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
