1. Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. The petitioners applied for mutual transfer. Their application is pending consideration at the end of the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Nadia.
3. Without going into the merits of the application, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Nadia to consider the said application in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of 90 days from the date of communication of this order. A reasoned

order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners immediately thereafter.

4. Petitioner no. 2 was last transferred in the year 2022. Since this is a case of mutual transfer, the restriction of putting in five years service prior to consideration of the application for transfer may not be made applicable in this case.
5. Learned advocate for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the application for seeking transfer to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.
6. The writ petition stands disposed of.
7. Urgent certified photocopy of this order, if applied for, be supplied to the parties expeditiously on compliance of usual legal formalities.
