The present writ petition was preferred by the writ petitioner praying for direction upon the respondents to accept the application of the petitioner and consider the relaxation of the qualifying age of the petitioner on the ground of longer experienced candidate and allow his candidature for recruitment for one of the posts of Pharmacist on purely contractual basis in the District Murshidabad as a special case as early as possible.
