1. Heard learned lawyers for both parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record including the injury report. Though she was in a hospital for a day, injuries does not appear to be life threatening.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S. Petitioner shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed and disposed of.
