1. Petitioner is not represented.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the opposite parties.

It appears that the instant application is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging the impugned order dated 10th June 2015 passed by the learned First Appellate Court in connection with Misc. Appeal No.11 of 2015. By passing the impugned order learned First Appellate Court affirmed the order passed by the learned Trial Court dated 10th June 2015 passed in connection with Title Suit No. 25 of 2015.
