This is an application wherein petitioner has prayed for expeditious disposal of Sessions Case No. 40 of 1986 presently pending before the learned Additional District and Sessions Judges, 1st Court, Suri, Birbhum.

The State is represented.

Upon hearing learned counsel appearing on behalf of both the parties it appears that the prayer is innocuous and if the prayer made in the application is allowed the opposite parties will have no cause to prejudice.

Accordingly, the service of application upon opposite parties is hereby dispensed with.

On perusal of the prayer it appears that the above-mentioned Sessions Case is pending since 1986. Accordingly, the prayer made by the petitioner for expeditious disposal of the said case is quite justified.
