Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Petitioner before us is the husband.

Police complaint was lodged within four years of marriage.

The de facto complainant suffered burn injuries.

Petitioner claimed not to be present at the time and place of occurrence.

However, there is an allegation of torture and demand for dowry.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
