C.R.M.(A) 4937 of 2023

Three persons suffered injuries in an assault. One of the injuries was classified as 'grievous hurt'.

The person, suffering the injury of grievous hurt, stated that Pintu Pradhan and Madan Pradhan dealt blow on his head with iron rod leading to the grievous injury.

Other petitioners are named as persons, who did not cause the grievous hurt.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of

Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners will report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM (A) 4937 of 2023 is disposed of.
