- 1.** Affidavit-of-service filed today be kept on record.
- 2.** Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners applied for certified copy of a registered deed but has not yet been given copy of the same.
- 3.** Learned counsel for the respondent-authorities contends that the petitioners have to apply under Section 57(3) of the Registration Act, upon which such copy can be issued to the petitioners.
- 4.** It is further contended by the respondent-authorities that the petitioners have merely written a letter to the registering authorities seeking such certified copy, for which the same could not be given.
- 5.** Accordingly, WPA No. 25405 of 2023 is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioners to apply in proper format for a certified copy of the deed-in-question, in which case, upon compliance of all formalities by the petitioners, the respondent-authorities shall issue such

certified copy to the petitioners as expeditiously thereafter as possible.

- 6.** There will be no order as to costs.
- 7.** Urgent photostat certified copies of this order, if applied for, be made available to the parties upon compliance with the requisite formalities.
