1. Petitioner is in custody for more than a year. He submits recovery is not supported by independent witnesses. Accordingly, he prays for bail.
2. Learned Advocate for the State opposes the bail prayer.
3. We have considered the materials on record. Stolen articles were recovered from the petitioner. He has criminal antecedents. Trial is in progress.
4. Under such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
5. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

6. Trial court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date without granting unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.
