An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Bhagwangola** Police Station Case No. **297** of **2023** dated **04.07.2023** under Sections 341/323/325/307/34 of the Indian penal Code.

A person suffered two injuries in the incident of assault.

Both are cut injuries. One was on the scalp of 3.00 cm which was classified as dangerous.

Police filed charge sheet.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners in the incident, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each , with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the

jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
