In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/ Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in connection with Jagatballavpur Police Station Case No. 129/2024 dated 25.6.2024 under Sections 498A/302/304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. Charge-sheet submitted under Sections 498A/304B/306/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Petitioner is in custody for 170 days. Investigation is complete. There is no chance of abscondence.
3. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion, further custodial detention of the petitioner is not necessary. He may be enlarged on bail.
4. Accordingly, we direct the petitioner, namely, **Tusar Bag @ Tusar Kanti Bag @ Saheb** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Howrah, subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on each and every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate

witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

5. In the event petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the Trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail without any further reference to this Court.
6. The application for bail is, thus, allowed and disposed of.
