The instant application has been filed with a prayer for condonation of delay of 21 days in filing the Special Leave Petition to file appeal against the judgment and order of acquittal passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipore, South 24-Parganas in connection with Complaint Case No. AC 3895 of 2015 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.
