1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. There was a free fight by and between the parties. Case and counter case were registered. Nature of injuries is not grievous nor they attract the graver offence i.e. attempt to murder.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Samsul Alam @ Samshul Alam Sekh** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
