This is an application for restoration of the writ
petition being WPA 25762 of 2023 by recalling order
dated 17th December, 2024.

By order dated 17th December, 2024, the writ
petition has been dismissed for default.

Ms. Nandita Baksi, learned Advocate appearing for
the petitioners submits that, on the date the matter was
taken up, the learned Advocate failed to appear,
resulting in dismissal of the writ petition. She seeks for
restoration of the writ petition upon recalling the order
of dismissal.

Mr. Lalit Mohan Mahata, learned Additional Government Pleader leaves the matter to the discretion of the Court.
