In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Lalgola Police Station Case No. 818 of 2024 dated 04.08.2024 under Section 376(3) of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 4 of the POCSO Act and Section 12 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Further statement of the victim is exonerative. There was a romantic relationship between two young persons.
3. In view of the aforesaid, we are of the opinion petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., ***Najibur Rahaman*** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
