In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Hemtabad Police Station Case No. 96 of 2024 dated 19.05.2024 under Sections 498A/328/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record including the statement of the victim lady. She has alleged petitioner No.3 viz., **Saidur Rahaman @ Saidul Ali** had administered poison.
3. Hence, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.
4. Allegations against other petitioner Nos.1 and 2 are general and omnibus.
5. Hence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to them.
6. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner Nos. **1) Mohammad Mahsin @ Mohammad Mahsin Ali and 2) Mamena Khatun** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

7. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
