In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Nakashipara Police Station Case No. 846 of 2024 dated 20.09.2024 under Sections 115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/109/329(3)/351(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Serious injury was caused by petitioner No.1 Mojahar Sk. @ Mejehar Sekh with a sharp cutting weapon.
3. Hence, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.
4. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner No. ***1) Mojahar Sk. @ Mejehar Sekh*** is rejected.
5. Moreover, keeping in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner Nos.2) Jahanabi @ Janhab Sk. @ Sekh and 3) Kabila Bibi @ Kabila Khatun Bibi in the crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
6. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., ***2) Jahanabi @ Janhab Sk. @ Sekh and 3) Kabila Bibi @ Kabila Khatun Bibi*** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also

subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

7. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
