In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Girish Park** Police Station Case No.**184 of 2023** dated **01.10.2023** under Sections **408/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (G.R. Case No.1032 of 2023).

Apparently, the police complaint revolves around banking transactions.

It is the claim of the petitioner that the petitioner resigned from the services while it is the claim of the bank that, there was a show-cause issued to the petitioner.

Amount involved is slightly in excess of Rs.2 lacs.

Considering the gravity of the offence, materials in the case diary and the involvement of the petitioner in the incident, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner

shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 5052 of 2023 is, thus, disposed of.
