1. Heard learned Advocates for both the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Injuries are not grievous or life threatening. Incident occurred in course of a political clash. Possibility of false implication due to petitioner's political affiliation cannot be ruled out. Investigation is complete. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary and he may be granted anticipatory bail.
3. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the petitioner, namely, ***Subhankar Santra @ Achinta Santra***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further

condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
