Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner alleges police inaction and submits that all the relevant sections that were imputable in the FIR were not imputed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the private respondents denies the allegations made in the writ petition.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State relies on the report and submits that on the complaint of the petitioner, a specific FIR was registered being Chakdah PS Case No.814 dated 14.11.2023 under Sections 341, 323, 325, 34 of the IPC. The accused was arrested.
