The grievance of the petitioner is directed against non-issuance of a duplicate death certificate in respect of the petitioner's brother-in-law. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that despite making representation, the concerned authorities have not taken any steps to issue a duplicate death certificate in respect of the brother-in-law of the petitioner.

The Panchayat Authorities are represented and submit that, they have no objection if a duplicate death certificate is issued in respect of the brother-in-law of the petitioner.

In view of the above, W.P.A. No. 27761 of 2024 stands disposed of by directing the respondent no. 3 or the respondent no. 4 to issue a duplicate death
