**C. R. M. (A) 4082 of 2024**

In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Joypur Police Station Case No. 341 of 2024 dated 09.11.2024 under Sections 126(2)/117(2)/109(1)/74/118(2)/3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. There are case and counter case between the parties. Medical report does not show the injury to be grievous.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., ***1) Deluar Ali Khan @ Deluwar Ali Kha, 2) Safik Ali Khan, 3) Somrat Ali Khan @ Samrat Khan, 4) Lakshmi Ali Khan @ Nasim Ali Kha and 5) Anowar Ali Khan @ Anoyar Ali Khan*** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
