Police complaint was lodged within five years of marriage.  
De facto complainant recorded a statement under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code where she claims that she was administered poison.  
De facto complainant was hospitalized. Contemporaneous medical documents suggest a case of poisoning.  
In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.  
Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.
