In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure read with Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Digha** Police Station Case No. **65** of **2024** dated **12.11.2024** under Sections **329(3)/ 115(2)/ 118(2)/ 109/ 303(2)/ 74/ 324(4)/ 326(g)/ 351(3)/ 3(5)** of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

1. Heard the learned advocates for both the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Injury report shows that injuries are simple in nature.
3. In view of the aforesaid facts, we are of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary and petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. They shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.
6. The application being **CRM (A) 4096 of 2024** is, thus, disposed of.
