The petitioners seek release of payment of the amount in terms of the work order dated 07.11.2014 in connection with work order bearing reference e-NIT No. MAD/ULB/BHATPARA/DR-2/4000 dated 24.09.2014 e-Tender. ID:- -2014_MAD_25071_1.

Representation filed by the petitioners is pending consideration at the end of the Bhatpara Municipality.

Without entering into the merit of the claim of the petitioners, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the Board of Councilors, Bhatpara Municipality to consider the representation made by the petitioners in accordance with law, after giving a reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioners at

the earliest, but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.

If any amount is found due and payable, the same shall be released at the earliest.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners is directed to forward a copy of the representation dated 27th February, 2020 and other documents in support of the claim to the aforesaid respondent at the time of communicating the order of the Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
