

CRM (A) 5260 of 2023

In re : An application for Anticipatory Bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Bhupatinagar Police Station Case No. 378 of 2023 dated 20.09.2023 under Sections 341/323/325/326/307/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In an incident of assault there is a counter police complaint. Two persons apparently suffered injuries by knife, stick and bamboo. Injuries were not classified as grievous hurt by the treating doctor.

Considering the injuries and the incident, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner nos.1, 2 and 3 shall report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and the petitioner no.4 shall cooperate with the investigation and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed

for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

Hence, the application for anticipatory bail is disposed of.
