Four persons were injured in an incident of assault. Two injuries were classified as grievous hurt.

We perused those two injury reports and found that such injured suffered cut injuries on the scalp. Such injuries were classified as grievous hurt. The other injuries were classified as simple injury.

Considering such materials in the case diary, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the

conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. The petitioner nos. 6 to 9 will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the completion of the investigation and the petitioner nos. 1 to 5 will cooperate with the investigation till the completion of the investigation. The petitioners shall appear on every date before the Jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
