**IN THE HIGH COURT AT CALCUTTA  
CRIMINAL REVISIONAL JURISDICTION**

**C.R.R. 4594 of 2023**

In the matter of : **Biswanath Haldar & Anr.** ... Petitioners.

Earlier this revisional application was called on 11.12.2023 when accommodation was prayed for on behalf of the petitioners.

Today also when the revisional application has been called, none represents the petitioners.

The revisional application was preferred for setting aside the order dated 12.09.2023 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, 9<sup>th</sup> Court, Alipore in connection with complaint case being A.C. No. 929 of 2023. I find from the records that the said case was initiated for the alleged offences under Sections 363/340/34 of the Indian Penal Code. A prayer was also advanced under Section 97 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Having regard to the approach and attitude of the petitioners before this Court, I am of the opinion that the petitioners are not interested to pursue the revisional application.

Accordingly, the revisional application being CRR 4594 of 2023 is dismissed for default.
