Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were residing separately from the victim and her family.

There is a declaration recorded by the victim before the doctor treating her.

Medical evidence corroborates such ingestion.

In such circumstances, considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners in the incident, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

CRM(A) 5347 of 2023 is dismissed.
