1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. Report is placed on record.
3. We have considered the materials on record including the injury report. Though injuries are on a vital part of the body, they do not appear to be grievous. Victims were treated as outdoor patients and released.
4. Hence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
5. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., ***1) Partha Deyasin @ Diyasin, 2) Dipankar Deyasin @ Dinasin*** and ***3) Ajoy Deyasin @ Dinasin*** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. They shall appear before the

jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

6. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
