1. Heard the learned Counsels for the parties.

2. We have considered the materials on record.

Having considered the injury report co-accused, Israil Sardar has been granted anticipatory bail. Petitioner stands on the same footing and is entitled to similar relief.

3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on condition that he shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
