There is no representation on behalf of the opposite parties.

It appears that the instant application is filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India challenging the judgment and order dated 18th July, 2014 passed by the learned Trial Court. It further appears that during pendency of this application, some of the opposite parties have been expired and an application has been taken out on behalf of the petitioners for substitution of the heirs/legal representatives of those opposite parties after condoning the delay and after setting aside of abatement.
