1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. There was a free fight between two groups. Case and counter case were registered. We have also gone through the injury report which does not show injuries are grievous.
3. Under such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners viz., **(1) Sudam Ch. Das @ Sudam Chandra Das @ Sudam Das, (2) Rabindranath Das @ Rabin Chandra Das, (3) Bipra Kr. Das @ Bipra Kumar Das, (4) Sambhu Charan Das, (5) Dulal Ch. Das @ Dulal Chandra Das, (6) Sourav Das @ Sourabh Das and (7) Tarun Kr. Das @ Tarun Das** be released

on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. They shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
