Report filed by the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by a Division Bench of this Court on 12.12.2024 in CRM(A) 4313 of 2024, inter alia, on the condition to meet the Officer-in-Charge of the local police station once a week until further orders. The petitioners have complied with the same. Now, charge-sheet has been submitted.

Heard learned counsel for the State.

In view of the above and the interest of justice, I am inclined to allow the relaxation of condition of anticipatory bail by waiving the condition to meet the Officer-in-Charge of the local police station once a week until further orders. The rest of the order shall remain same.

The petitioners shall attend the jurisdictional court regularly.

Accordingly, the application being CRAN 1 of 2025 is disposed of.
