In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed on 03.12.2024 in connection with Santipur Police Station Case No.197 of 2024 dated 12.02.2024 under Sections 420/272/273 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 16 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 and Section 57 of the Food Safety Standard Act, 2006. (G.R. Case No.602 of 2024)

1. Heard learned Advocates for both the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. We have also examined the chemical examiner's report. Report does not show the seized food items are harmful for human consumption. In view of the aforesaid fact, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioner for progress of investigation is not necessary and he may be granted anticipatory bail.
3. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner, namely, ***Bijoy Krishna Saha***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
