C.R.M.(A) 5491 of 2023

In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Sankrail** Police Station Case No. **718** of **2023** dated **20.09.2023** under Section **306** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Apparently, husband committed suicide.

Petitioner before us is the wife. Allegation against the petitioner is that, she entered into an amorous relationship. Be that as it may, complicity of the petitioner in abetting suicide, if there be any, may be decided at the trial.

In such circumstances we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and

also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.

CRM(A) 5491 of 2023 is disposed of.
