1. Heard learned Advocates for the respective parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Allegations against the petitioner are general and omnibus. Injuries are not grievous. Petitioner does not stand on the same footing with co-accused viz. Suman Ghosh who had outraged the modesty of the lady. In view of the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the crime, we are of the opinion his custodial interrogation is not necessary and he may be granted anticipatory bail.
3. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner, namely, ***Bishnupada Roy @ Bistu Roy***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down

under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
