Mr. Roy, Id. Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the State, has submitted a report prepared by the officer in charge of Alipore P.S.

The contents of the report reflects that the investigation of the case has been closed declaring it as '*civil in nature*' and prays for discharge of all the accused persons before the Id. CJM, Alipore in connection with Alipore P.S. Case No. 100 dated 20.11.2023.

Having considered the report so submitted, I am of the view that the prayer so advanced in the present revisional application has become infructuous.

Accordingly, CRR 4761 of 2023 along with CRAN 1 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending application, if any, is also disposed of.

However, the petitioner should approach the Id. Trial court for any other remedies available.
