1. Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record including the injury report. It is to be assessed during trial whether injuries are grievous.
3. In the light of the aforesaid, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Faruk Sk. @ Abdul Faruk Sk. Abdul Furak Sk.** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
