In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed on 05.12.2024 in connection with Hariharpara Police Station Case No.718 of 2024 dated 12.10.2024 under Sections 118(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. (G.R. Case No.5380 of 2024)

1. Heard learned Advocates for both the parties.
2. We are informed petitioner no.1 has been arrested in the meantime.
3. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail so far as petitioner no.1 namely, ***(1) Dipankar Halder @ Dipanker Halder*** is concerned stands dismissed as infructuous.
4. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner no.2 is not the assailant. Principal assailant has been arrested. In view of extent of involvement of the petitioner no.2, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of petitioner no.2 is not necessary and he may be granted anticipatory bail.
5. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner no.2, namely, ***(2) Sanat Halder***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further

condition that the petitioner no.2 shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

6. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
