1. Despite service of notice, the State is not represented. Affidavit of service filed in Court is taken on record.
2. The petitioner claims interest on delayed payment of terminal benefits. The petitioner superannuated from service of the WBTCCL on July 31, 2020. He received his terminal benefits of Rs.37,19,341.24 on 11.11.2020.
3. The petitioner is entitled to interest for the period from 01.08.2020 to 11.11.2020 at the rate of 6 per cent per annum. Let the same be paid to the petitioner by the WBTCCL within a period of one month from date.

4. In default of payment as directed above, the rate of interest shall stand increased to 9 per cent per annum.
5. The issue of interest payable on differential gratuity is the subject matter of an appeal being A.P.O.T. No. 243 of 2022 (West Bengal Transport Corporation Limited & Ors. – Vs. – Pravakar Ghosh & Ors.). The payment by the respondents of the same to the petitioner shall be subject to the result of the said appeal.
6. The writ petition is disposed of.
7. There will be no order as to costs.
