1. Heard learned Advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Though injuries are grievous the incident occurred in the course of a free fight and is not a pre-meditated one.
3. Keeping in mind these facts, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner viz., **Rentu Mondal** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. He shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
