1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Husband has been granted regular bail. It appears that the victim died due to hanging which indicates suicidal hanging. Petitioners are the in-laws of the victim lady. Allegations against them are general and omnibus.
3. Under such circumstances we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.
4. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of BNSS 2023.
5. Petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
6. The application being CRM (A) 4463 of 2024 is disposed of.
