C.R.M. (A) 5654 of 2023

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Bishnupur** Police Station Case No.**219 of 2023** dated **01.11.2023** under Sections **409/420/120B/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.(G.R. Case No.1366 of 2023).

Apparently, the police complaint revolves around transactions taking place between January 5, 2022 to March 22, 2023. Petitioner was employee of the company. Petitioner subsequently resigned. Police complaint was lodged after ten months of his resignation.

Police complaint revolves around alleged defaults.

As to whether, petitioner was involved in the so-called default or not, may be decided at the trial.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the

conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 5654 of 2023 is, thus, disposed of.
