1. Heard learned lawyers for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner contends co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail. Petitioner stands on the same footing and is entitled to similar relief.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of BNSS 2023.
4. Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.
5. The application being CRM (A) 4501 of 2024 is disposed of.
